

# Patrol Planning

Create defined hotspots, plan patrol routes, track resources, create reports and analyse performance against set criteria.

Patrol Planning is our new licensed addition, which enables forces to plan, track and report against defined patrol locations.

This solution has been specifically designed to assist police forces in the following areas of business:

- Defining **ASB Hotspot** (Anti-Social Behaviour) locations, managing patrols and collecting resource allocation data to facilitate reporting for the Governments ASB Action Plan.
- Assisting forces with **Problem Management Plans** and the use of SARA methodology (Scanning, Analysis, Response, Assessment) to deal with repeat community based issues.
- Providing accurate response data for analysis and improved evidence base assessments.
- Providing a function to highlight and track resource activity against locations associated with **Serious Violence** and managing the patrols of 'Grip Funding' areas.
- Creating bespoke plans to provide high visibility in areas experiencing Community Tensions, clearly identifying locations of key interest for extra reassurance patrols.

Patrol Planning reduces the pressure on control rooms, moving 'slow-time' management away, and allowing control rooms to remain focussed on critical and emergency response. The reporting capability will also grow meaningful insight into problem areas, increase adherence with planned patrol times and reduce human resource time analysing response data associated with the patrols, as well as provide accurate reporting of patrol times spent in each defined location. This data can support neighbourhood performance frameworks, assist with community feedback and aid formal reporting to key stakeholders.
